




You are part of the solution

The Outreach Team

- Municipal coordinator (staff or Green Team member) should lead
- Assemble outreach team to implement residential/ commercial outreach
 - Understand the community's needs
 - Identify and work with key community partners
 - Create Outreach Plan* of community-based initiatives (*SJ provides a template)
- Work with the utility-designated representative to coordinate the Plan
